10. Hostel & Mess Details

The hostel and mess facilities for academic year 2023 – 24 are as follows

- Hostel residency (AC and Non-AC) with attached bathrooms, are available for boys and girls.
 - The number of Air-Conditioned (AC) rooms in both boys and girls hostel blocks are limited and would be allotted on a first-come-first serve basis in the first year
- Every hostel provides facilities like uninterrupted electricity, solar / electric heated water facility, water cooler with aqua guard filters, common telephone, television and a reading rooms
 - Student will have to bring their own soft furnishings and bed linen.
- Food courts are conveniently located and serve both Veg and Non-Veg cuisines
 - Joining a Mess is mandatory for students residing in the MAHE Hostels
- Staying in campus hostels is compulsory for all students and are accommodated in designated hostels only
 - If the student vacates the hostel, his / her hostel facilities fee paid for the year will be forfeited
- Hostel Fee and Mess Charges has to be remitted by wire transfer along with the first-year course fee (Refer Section 8 for Payment process details)
