1. OUR PHILOSOPHY FOR HOSTELS:

MAHE, Bengaluru hostels are a mélange of different types of rooms to best suit the students having varying requirements. There is a dedicated team of officials and workers to make the stay of students comfortable providing an ambience of *'Home Away from Home.'*

The hostel environment is conducive for learning for students from all disciplines which includes Engineering, Design, Management, Commerce, Law and other Liberal Arts programs and takes care of the housing, food, recreational and wellness of all students. Many students from different geographical backgrounds study, mingle and play together making it a vibrant campus at MAHE, Bengaluru.

Hostel accommodations are a valuable service that is provided to students pursuing UG courses, it is a facility that is made available to those who meet certain criteria and fulfill specific requirements. The provision of hostel facilities is based on factors such as availability, need, and eligibility. It is optional and not compulsory. While hostels play an important role in providing temporary accommodation for students, it is essential to recognize that access to hostels is not guaranteed for everyone, but rather allocated based on various considerations and prioritization. We encourage local students to opt for transport facility, provided by MAHE at cost.

All students are expected to abide by the rules and regulations defined by MAHE and other governing bodies. Necessary undertakings have to be submitted by the students, parents, guardians as applicable. We believe it is our joint responsibility to make the hostel and campus safe place for all.

2. REGISTRATION AT THE HOSTELS:

Hostel registration/allotment can be done only through the Hostel Management System, which is a simple online process and the same can be done by following the below steps.

STEP-I:

- ❖ The Hostel room allotment process will be enabled in a phased manner from May 2024.
- All hostel bookings will be done as per the institution-wise allocation plan, availability, and payment.
- ❖ The allotment will be through the online portal HRA (Hostel Room Allotment). The detailed guidelines and the URL for the same will be available at the college website.
 - Note Hostel allocation for students seeking admission in MIT courses will be done in alignment with the counseling schedule.





STEP-II:

The HRA will enable the students to:

- Select category of room from the various MAHE Bengaluru hostel blocks (within and outside the campus), based on availability.
- Make necessary payment online.
- Download the receipt and
- Download the Hostel room allotment letter online.

8. FACILTIES

- **Mess Services and Food Court** All students living in hostels have access to food and beverages from vendors who have been approved by MAHE B'LRU campus. All Hostel students are required to be members of the Mess. They can also access different food outlets inside the food courts on a chargeable basis.
- **Medical Facility** Medical cards are provided to students, and they can be utilized at most of the Manipal Hospitals on chargeable basis. The health coordinators and wardens will aid hostel residents in need of immediate medical attention. Manipal clinics are available on the campus and in outside hostels to cater to the requirements. 24X7 ambulance service is available to take care of emergency cases. Counselors are available at the campus and 24/7 counselling portal YourDost can be accessed for any support needed.
- **Sports and Marena Facility** All students have access to the campus's well-lit stadium, basketball court, volleyball court, cricket field, and lawn tennis court. Students can take membership of Marena to avail various other fitness facilities.
- Wi-Fi High-speed Wi-Fi access is available throughout the hostel premises.
- **Stationary store** There is a well-stocked stationery store on campus. Find all your essential stationery needs conveniently located on-site. Xerox/Printing facility also available on a chargeable basis
- **Unisex Salon** Grooming services available at our unisex salon.
- ATM Centers MAHE B'LRU has ATMs on campus, thus students are advised not to carry a lot of cash.
- **Laundry Services** This is a compulsory facility and the fees for the same is included and charged as mentioned in the hostel fee structure.
- **Utilities** Solar-heated water facilities, water coolers, and 24-hour electricity and water supply are available in every hostel.
- **Infrastructure provided** The hostel provides a cot, a mattress, a study table, a chair, and a cupboard (keep valuables under lock and key) for each student.
- **CCTV Surveillance and security-** The entire campus including hostel area is under CCTV surveillance and as a very strong security team round the clock.
- **Transport** MAHE B'LRU Campus has dedicated buses and provides pick-up and drop services on a chargeable basis to the students from the campus to different parts of the city on the approved routes which cover a major part of the city. Interested students may choose the nearest bus stop to their residence. For students residing in the outside hostels, transport facilities are provided at no extra cost according to the academic schedule.
- **Wardens and other staff available round the clock -** Our Wardens, Security, HK staff and health coordinators are available round the clock to assist you with any concerns or queries.
- **Parcel Management Support** Parcel management support is available to manage all E-com deliveries.
- **Campus mart** Campus mart is available at the campus to help students access necessities.
