Introduction:

Recent major earthquakes, tsunamis, hurricanes, floods and other natural disasters have resulted in huge loss to human life and destroyed properties. A new range of human made disasters have afflicted humanity in modern times. It is important to understand the nature of these global risks, and develop strategies not only to prepare for these events but also to plan effective responses for disaster management and its associated human health impacts. The conference provides a forum for exchange of information between academics and practitioners, and a venue for presentation of the latest developments in the field.

Need:

Karnataka State has been confronting various natural calamities. The coastal districts are under constant threat of dangers originating due to its close proximity to oceans.

It is important to note that 11 districts in the State fall under the seismic zone 3. A total of 42,173 hectares of land is under moderate damage risk zone 3. Coastal erosion is also causing havoc in the three coastal districts of Karnataka. According to the Karnataka State Natural Disaster Monitoring Centre, Kodagu which is one of the district in south karnataka was worst hit by the south - west monsoon during June 2018. Being aware of the skills, outreach services during emergencies and actions to be prepared are the aims of this conference.

Goal:

Goal of the conference is to prepare an interdisciplinary team, which helps to plan and implement disaster management programs at the society level.

Objectives:

- The participants will be able to:
1. identify the basic concepts, terminology and models of disaster risk management.
 2. outline casualty response and on-site mass casualty management.
 3. develop skills required for providing outreach services in emergencies.
 4. discuss about injuries and infections during disasters.
 5. compare roles and responsibilities of various health personnel.
 6. plan activation of rescue operations and management.
 7. apply psychological first aid in disaster situations.
 8. discuss the active role of nurses in disaster situations.
